

VEG OUT 2020 Vendor Terms & Conditions

1. Vendor (You) understands the Application for participation in VEG OUT is not binding between the Vendor and Capital Region Vegan Network (CRVN) until the Application is executed by CRVN. CRVN reserves the right to refuse a potential Vendor. At the time of execution, the Application becomes a binding contract between Vendor and CRVN. Vendor will receive confirmation of Vendor's participation in writing by email from CRVN.
2. Prior to booth set-up, exhibitors must sign in with CRVN staff or volunteers and pay any outstanding fees. Vendor tear-down is not to occur before 3:00 pm and each Vendor should give respect to other Vendors' safety. Please check the CRVN website or Vendor Guidelines for further set-up and tear-down details.
3. Property, materials, and food are displayed at Vendor's own risk. Vendor indemnifies and holds harmless CRVN as well as CRVN's directors, employees, and agents for any loss of property, property damage, or personal injury.
4. Vendor must have adequate signage clearly identifying the name of their business/organization.
5. Vendors may not provide samples, sell, or otherwise distribute non-vegan products (**VEGAN** means no dairy, animal flesh, poultry, seafood, broth made from animal flesh, animal fat, gelatin, eggs, milk, cheese, butter, whey, casein, honey, and insect derivatives).
6. Vendors are only permitted to sell food items at VEG OUT. (If you would like to sell or exhibit non-food items, please consider signing up to be an exhibitor at our VegFest.)
7. Vendor agrees to alternate service between the VEG OUT fast pass line and the general attendee line at their booth.¹
8. Vendor agrees to allow CRVN to photograph them in event photos and will allow CRVN to use such photos on CRVN's website, publications, and future marketing efforts.
9. In the event an occurrence outside of CRVN's control interrupts or prevents the holding of VEG OUT, CRVN, its directors, employees, and agents shall not be liable to vendors. As registration fees are disbursed before VEG OUT for operating costs, supplies, and marketing promotion, said fees will not be refunded.
10. Vendor agrees to keep its booth and the area in front of its booth free of debris at all times.
11. Vendor fees are non-refundable once accepted to be a Vendor by CRVN.
12. Any and all checks returned by the bank are subject to a \$20 return check penalty fee.

¹ The VEG OUT fast pass allows attendees to obtain quicker service in each vendor line. There are a limited number of passes and the revenue from the passes helps to offset costs to CRVN throughout the year.

13. These terms shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York. Should any provision of the Vendor Terms & Conditions be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable to any extent under applicable law, that provision will be enforced to the maximum extent permissible, and the remaining provisions of these terms will remain in full force and effect.

ZERO WASTE INITIATIVE

In an effort to move toward a more environmentally friendly and sustainable festival model and lessen the amount of trash generated, CRVN encourages all vendors to utilize as much compostable material as possible for anything that is to be purchased and disposed of by festival attendees during the festival including but not limited to food containers, plates, utensils, cups, etc. While the Zero Waste Initiative is strongly encouraged for VEG OUT 2020, use of compostable products will become mandatory for vendors at VEG OUT 2021.
